Dear All,

We are very excited about our Badger's Preschool opening in April 2017. This letter will explain what to expect, what to bring and what to wear!

What will your Child need to bring?

We will be outside all morning and because we live in the UK that means we can experience all weather conditions in the space of an hour ⁽²⁾! So with that in mind, your child will need to bring the following items to ensure we are prepared for all weather conditions. We recommend that these items are carried in a NAMED RUCKSACK.

- Layers of light clothing, ideally tops with long sleeves
- Sun hat
- A waterproof outer layer, top and bottom please ask in advance if you require any help with this as we may have spares.
- Waterproof shoes in case it is muddy, we recommend walking boots, wellies or shoes, but you can send them in trainers as long as they are sturdy. NO open shoes please.
- NO shorts please, however hot it is, we have brambles and nettles –ouch!
- Suitable sun care.

Food & Drink

Please provide a healthy snack for your child and a drink of water in a named bottle. If your child is staying for lunch club please provide a packed lunch.

We will always have drinking water available and as a treat we may even toast some marshmallows on the fire and make Smores! If your child has any dietary requirements, please clearly stipulate these in the enrolment form.

Food, drink and waterproofs should be in a rucksack marked with your child's name, these will be put on your child's peg in the outdoor cloakroom. It's also sensible to make sure that waterproofs are name tagged as they all look alike and have a tendency to get thrown on and off.

Payments

For those receiving the NEF funding (up to 15 hours) you just need to complete the funding form and return to us. Funded places will be confirmed 4 weeks before the start of each term. For term dates please see our website.

If you are paying for sessions or having Early Morning club 8:30am – 9:30am or Lunch Club 12:00pm-12:30 pm we will invoice you at the beginning of term. Non-payment will result in termination of your child's place.

Insects

We do share the woods with other animals, which is part of the joy of being there of course. Mostly we get along fine, but there are a few beasties that can be problematic:

Mosquitos, wasps and bees: We rarely get stings, but they do happen. If your child is allergic to wasp or bee stings make sure we know (registration form) and if they need Piriton (or anything stronger) then send it along with them.

Ticks: It is unlikely that we will encounter ticks but they can be an issue when you are in the woods. Ticks are small parasites that lurk in long grass or ferns and attach themselves to bare skin, which is why we ask for your child to wear trousers, long sleeved tops and closed shoes. They can look like a small scab. If our leaders see a child has a tick they will remove it using a tick key, and inform you on pick up. If you notice a tick on your child, don't panic, but do remove it carefully as soon as you can. DON'T just yank it out (this is a bad idea). Use a tick key or other device if you have one, or a loop of cotton thread if you don't. There is a handy guide to tick removal here. Ticks can carry Lyme disease, which is potentially serious, though treatable with antibiotics. If your child has a tick, then remove it and keep it in a plastic bag. If your child develops a rash, joint pain or fever then your GP may be able to test the tick to see if it carries the disease. You can email or call us if you need advice.

How to find us

Located 5 miles out of Newmarket. Follow A11 from Newmarket and take the second exit signposted Chippenham (B1085). Follow the road through the village and take a right turn
